According to David Bohm, one of the most significant theoretical physicists of the 20th century, **matter is** "condensed or frozen light." In fact, Sir James Jeans concluded that the whole physical universe is composed of waves, or radiation.

The bottled waves we call matter, and the unbottled waves we call light, which reduces the universe to a world of light, potential or existent,) "...so that the whole story of creation can be told with perfect accuracy and completeness in the six words from the Book of Genesis, "God said, 'Let there be light.'" [Sir James Jeans]



The first revelation which God gives to man is that He is the Lord our God and that there is none else, as He told Moses, "I AM THAT I AM" [Exodus 3:14]. The second is that mankind is the object of God's never failing love. The entire universe and everything contained therein was and is created to bear witness of these ultimate truths.

"When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; what is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him?" [Psalms 8:3–4]

The word "universe" refers to four items, namely, space, time, matter, and energy. All of which are mentioned in the first verse in the Bible. For God said "In the beginning (time) God created (energy) the heaven (space) and the earth (matter)" [Genesis 1:1]. While Christianity believes there was a beginning to the universe and that it had a cause by which it began, theists have traditionally thought that a static, or non-contracting or non-expanding, universe has always existed without any cause.

In 1915, **Albert Einstein** presented the theory of general relativity, which explained for the first time that the universe could not possibly be static. It had to be expanding or contracting. Einstein struggled to believe this until **Edwin Hubble** gathered empirical evidence in 1929 that every galaxy is moving rapidly away from us.

In the 1920's, two physicists created a model for the creation of the universe utilizing Einstein's equations, also known as the **big bang model**. The model states that the universe did not exist prior to an explosion that occurred 13.8 billion years ago.

This means there was literally **nothing** (no space, no time, no matter, and no energy) before the explosion. The "Standard Model of the Universe" states the universe literally sprang forth from nothing. **The book of Genesis claims the same thing**.

1:2 And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep... 1:3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. [Genesis 1:2-3]
