And again, this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world, for a witness unto all nations, and then shall the end come, or the destruction of the wicked.

...then shall appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven; and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn.

And they shall see the Son of Man coming in the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory.

And whoso treasureth up my words, shall not be deceived.

Therefore be ye also ready; for in such an hour as ye think not, the Son of Man cometh.

←(Cont.) But if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My Lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to smite his fellow-servants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; the Lord of the servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, and shall cut him asunder, and shall appoint him his portion with the hypocrites; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

And thus cometh the end of the wicked according to the prophecy of Moses, saying, They should be cut off from among the people. But the end of the earth is not yet; but bye and bye.

Behold, the day has come, when the cup of the wrath of mine indignation is full.  - **an exceeding great many of people do stumble**
 - **Satan hath great power over people**

Destruction of the Wicked

But as it was in the days of Noah, so it shall be also at the coming of the Son of Man. For it shall be with them as it was in the days which were before the flood; for until the day that Noah entered into the ark, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, and knew not until the flood came and took them all away; **so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.**

Matthew 24:44-45 & Mark 13:48-49



Destruction of the Wicked

And as it was in the days of Noe; so shall it be also in the days of the Son of Man. They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all. Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded; But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom, it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all. **Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed.**

Destruction of the Wicked

For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest; for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss; but he himself may be saved; yet so as by fire. Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.

I Corinthians 3:11-17



Destruction of the Wicked

For the day soon cometh, that all the proud and **they who do wickedly**, shall be as stubble; and the day cometh that they must be burned. For the time soon cometh, that the fullness of the wrath of God shall be poured out upon all the children of men: For he will not suffer that the wicked shall destroy the righteous. Wherefore, he will preserve the righteous by his power, even if it be so that the fullness of his wrath must come, and the righteous be preserved, even unto the destruction of their enemies by fire. Wherefore, the righteous need not fear; for thus saith the prophet, They shall be saved, even if it so be as by fire.

1 Nephi 3:33-37

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in the which the heavens shall shake, and the earth also shall tremble, and the mountains shall melt, and pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall be filled with fervent heat; the earth also shall be filled, and the corruptible works which are therein shall be burned up.

For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and **all that do wickedly**, shall be stubble; and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the Lord of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

Behold, now it is called today (until the coming of the Son of man), and verily it is a day of sacrifice, and a day for the tithing of my people; for he that is tithed shall not be burned (at his coming); for after to day cometh the burning: this is speaking after the manner of the Lord; for verily I say, Tomorrow all the proud and they that do wickedly shall be as stubble; and I will burn them up, for I am the Lord of hosts; and **I will not spare any that remaineth in Babylon**. Wherefore, if ye believe me, ye will labor while it is called today.

For a desolating scourge shall go forth among the inhabitants of the earth, and shall continue to be poured out, from time to time, if they repent not, until the earth is empty, and the inhabitants thereof are consumed away, and utterly destroyed by the brightness of my coming.

But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for he is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap.



Wherefore **all those who are proud, and that do wickedly**, the day that cometh **shall burn them up**, saith the Lord of hosts, for **they shall be as stubble;**

And they that kill the prophets, and the saints, the depths of the earth shall swallow them up, saith the Lord of hosts: And mountains shall cover them, and whirlwinds shall carry them away, and buildings shall fall upon them, and crush them to pieces and grind them to powder; And they shall be visited with thunderings, and lightnings, and earthquakes, and all manner of destructions; For the fire of the anger of the Lord shall be kindled against them, and they shall be as stubble, and the day that cometh shall consume them, saith the Lord of hosts. O the pain, and the anguish of my soul for the loss of the slain of my people!



(←Cont.) For I, Nephi, hath seen it, and it well nigh consumeth me before the presence of the Lord: but I must cry unto my God, Thy ways are just. But behold, the righteous, that hearken unto the words of the prophets, and destroy them not, but look forward unto Christ with steadfastness for the signs which are given, notwithstanding all persecutions; behold they are they which shall not perish. But the Son of Righteousness shall appear unto them; and he shall heal them, and they shall have peace with him, until three generations shall have passed away and many of the fourth generation shall have passed away in righteousness.


Prophecy Fulfilled:

(3 Nephi 4:6-41 – we'll read only a portion of this)

- At Christ's death, wicked were destroyed (**refiner's fire**)
- Great destruction upon the land and the wicked
- More righteous were preserved (**fullers' soap**)
- Peace followed for four generations

And many great destructions have I caused to come upon this land, and upon this people, because of their wickedness and their abominations. O all ye that are spared, because ye were more righteous than

they, will ye not now return unto me, and repent of your sins, and be converted, that I may heal you?





And now in this two hundred and first year, there began to be among them those who were lifted up in pride, such as the wearing of costly apparel, and all manner of fine pearls, and of the fine things of the world. For which cause also, he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Some of whom were disobedient in the days of Noah, while the long-suffering of God waited, while the ark




was preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us, (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ;

Destruction of the Wicked

Wherefore the decree hath gone forth from the Father that they shall be gathered in unto one place, upon the face of this land, to prepare their hearts, and be prepared in all things, against the day when tribulation and desolation are sent forth upon the wicked;

for the hour is nigh, and the day soon at hand, when the earth is ripe; and all the proud, and **they that do wickedly**, shall be as stubble, and I will burn them up, saith the Lord of Hosts, **that wickedness shall not be upon the earth;**

D&C 28:2d-3a (Cont.)→



Destruction of the Wicked

←(Cont.) For the hour is nigh, and that which was spoken by mine apostles must be fulfilled; for as they spoke, so shall it come to pass;

For I will reveal myself from heaven with power and great glory, with all the hosts thereof, and dwell in righteousness with men on earth a thousand years, and the wicked shall not stand.

And again, verily, verily I say unto you, **and it hath gone forth in a firm decree, by the will of the Father,**

D&C 28:2d-3a

Nevertheless, if we shall endure, we shall be kept according to his promise. And we look for a new heavens, and a new earth wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent, that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot and blameless;

1 Peter 3:13-14

And because of the righteousness of his people,
Satan has no power; Wherefore, he can not be loosed
for the space of many years; For he hath no power



For the great millennial, which I have spoken by the mouth of my servants, shall come; for Satan shall be bound; and when he is loosed again, he shall only reign for a little season, and then cometh the end of the earth;

Why must the wicked be removed from the Earth?

- Because God decreed it
- So there can be righteousness
- So **Satan** can be bound

Levels of Righteousness or Wickedness:

When we die, we go to one of the following places:

Paradise

- Righteous
- Baptized
- Received Holy Ghost
- Church of God

Prison

- Heathen nations
- Were not taught about Jesus in the flesh

Hell

- Done wickedly on earth
- Received not Jesus nor the gospel

Outer Darkness

- **Wicked and rejected the Holy Ghost**
- **Not discuss further here**

Destruction of the Wicked

This is the testimony of the gospel of Christ, concerning them who come forth in the resurrection of the just: they are **they who received the testimony of Jesus**, and **believed on his name**, and **were baptized** after the manner of his burial, being **buried in the water** in his name, and this according to the commandment which he has given, that by keeping the commandments, they might be **washed and cleansed from all their sins**, and **receive the Holy Spirit by the laying on of the hands of him who is ordained and sealed unto this power**; and who **overcome by faith**, and are sealed by that Holy Spirit of promise, which the Father sheds forth upon all those who **are just and true**;

they are they who are the church of the Firstborn; they are they into whose hands the Father has given all things.

these shall dwell in the presence of God and his Christ for ever and ever: these are they whom he shall bring with him, when he shall come in the clouds of heaven, to reign on the earth

over his people; these **are they who shall have part in the first resurrection**; these are they who shall come forth in the resurrection of the just; these are they who are come unto Mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly place, the holiest of all;

D&C 76:5

Destruction of the Wicked

These are they who died without law; and also they who are the spirits of men kept in prison, whom the Son visited, and preached the gospel unto them, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, who received not the testimony of Jesus in the flesh, but afterwards received it; these are they who are honorable men of the earth, who were blinded by the craftiness of men: these are they who receive of his glory, but not of his fullness; these are they who receive of the presence of the Son, but not of the fullness of the Father. These are they who are not valiant in the testimony of Jesus.

And then shall the heathen nations be redeemed, and they that knew no law shall have part in the first resurrection; and it shall be tolerable for them; D&C 45:10a

The saints that are upon the earth, who are alive, shall be quickened, and be caught up to meet him. And they who have slept in their graves, shall come forth; for their graves shall be opened, and they also shall be caught up to meet him in the midst of the pillar of heaven: Then cometh the redemption of those who are Christ's at his coming; who have received their part in that prison which is prepared for them, that they might receive the gospel, and be judged according to men in the flesh. D&C 85:27b-28



Hell

Destruction of the Wicked

These are they who received not the gospel of Christ, neither the testimony of Jesus; these are they who deny not the Holy Spirit; these are they who are thrust down to hell; **these are they who shall not be redeemed from the Devil, until the last resurrection.** These all are they who will not be gathered with the saints, to be caught up unto the church of the Firstborn, and received into the cloud; these are they who are liars, and sorcerers, and adulterers, and whoremongers, and whosoever loves and makes a lie; these are they who suffer the wrath of God on the earth; these are they who suffer the vengeance of eternal fire; these are they who are cast down to hell and suffer the wrath of Almighty God until the fullness of times.

And for these many generations, even since the day that I created them, have they gone astray, and have denied me, and have sought their own counsels in the dark; and in their own abominations have they devised murder, and have not kept the commandments which I gave unto their father Adam. Wherefore, they have forsworn themselves, and by their oaths they have brought upon themselves death. And an hell I have prepared for them, if they repent not;

Genesis 6:28-30

Destruction of the Wicked

Therefore my people are gone into captivity, because they have no knowledge; and their honorable men are famished, and their multitude dried up with thirst. **Therefore hell has enlarged herself, and opened her mouth without measure;** and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp, and he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.

Isaiah 5;13-14

We saw the glory and the inhabitants of the telestial world **[those of hell], that they were as innumerable as the stars in the firmament of heaven, or as the sand upon the seashore.**

These are they who are thrust down to hell; **these are they who shall not be redeemed from the Devil, until the last resurrection.**

If the dead wicked do not have place in Zion, does it make sense that the living wicked remain?



Destruction of the Wicked

Those living in Zion:

For the day soon cometh, that all the proud and **they who do wickedly**, shall be as stubble; and the day cometh that they must be burned. For the time soon cometh, that the fullness of the wrath of God shall be poured out upon all the children of men: For he will not suffer that the wicked shall destroy the righteous. Wherefore, he will preserve the righteous by his power,

1 Nephi 3:33-36

And he that liveth in righteousness, shall be changed in the twinkling of an eye;

D&C 43:7d



Destruction of the Wicked

Those living in Zion:

In those days there shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days; for the child shall not die, but shall live to be an hundred years old; **but the sinner, living to be an hundred years old, shall be accursed.**

Isaiah 65:20


It appears that people will still desire to sin in their heart during the millennial reign.


Levels of Righteousness or Wickedness:

Conclusion

- When Jesus returns, he will **NOT** return as a lamb, rather he will return as a judge – as the **LION**
- Like as in the days of Noah and Lot, when Christ returns, the wicked will be destroyed
- It will be like a **refiner's fire** for the wicked and a **fullers' soap** for everyone else
- The earth **MUST** be cleansed so that there can be righteousness for 1,000 years, so Satan can be bound
- **Those that do wickedly** shall not have place in God's Kingdom on earth for 1,000 years

Destruction of the Wicked

Historical Example:

(before Golden Age of the Nephites)

- Zarahemla – caught fire
- Moroni – sank into the sea and all died
- Moronihah – became a great mountain
- Whole face of the land was changed
- Highways broken up and roads destroyed
- Many cities remained, but greatly damaged
- Whole earth became deformed
- Gilgal – sunk and everyone drown



Destruction of the Wicked

Historical Example (Cont.):

(before Golden Age of the Nephites)

- Jacobugath – destroyed with fire
- Government of the land was destroyed
- Laman, Josh, Gad, Kishkumen – burned with fire and all the people
- Onihah, Mocum, Jerusalem – water flooded
- Gadiandi, Gadiomnah, Jacob, Gimgimno – made hills and valleys



Destruction of the Wicked

When Christ Returns:

- Maybe our cities will be destroyed too
 - Fire, flooding, earthquakes, land changing
- Maybe many cities will remain, but greatly damaged
- Maybe our highways will be broken up and roads destroyed
- Maybe the whole face of the land will be changed or deformed
- Maybe our government will be destroyed

Analogy of refugees fleeing into a new country.

Ye are not sent forth to be taught, but to teach the children of men the things which I have put into your hands by the power of my Spirit; and **ye are to be taught from on high**. Sanctify yourselves and ye shall be endowed with power, that ye may give even as I have spoken. Hearken ye, for, behold, **the great day of the Lord is nigh at hand**. For the day cometh that the Lord shall utter his voice out of heaven; the heavens shall shake and the earth shall tremble, and the trump of God shall sound both long and loud, and shall say to the sleeping nations; **Ye saints arise and live; Ye sinners stay and sleep until I shall call again: wherefore gird up your loins, lest ye be found among the wicked. 
