Each reformer ascertained a level of truth, and with it, the Gospel message became ever so brighter. However, the Church was not in need of a reformation, but a **restoration**. Some of the early reformers longed for the day when the pure Gospel of Christ would be displayed in power and authority. **Not** to destroy men, but to build them up to a **higher truth**.

[Roger Williams] conceived "that the **apostasy** of Anti-Christ has so far corrupted all, that there can be <u>no</u> recovery out of that apostasy, <u>till</u> Christ shall send forth new apostles to plant churches <u>anew</u>."



Following the establishment of the Church after Christ's ascension, man slowly began to **transgress** the laws, **change** the ordinances, and **allow** abominable heresies to creep into the Church, so much so that the Church **fell away and apostatized** as the Lord promised. [Read 2 Ths 2:1-4, 2 Tim 4:3-4, 2 Cor 11:2-4, Rom 1:18-25, Act 20:29-31, 2 Pet 2:1-3, Gal 1:6-9, 2 John 1:9-10]

2:2 That ye be <u>not</u> soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. 2:3 Let <u>no</u> man deceive you by <u>any</u> means: for that day shall <u>not</u> come, <u>except</u> there come <u>a falling away</u> <u>first</u>, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; [2 Thessalonians 2:2-3]

As the centuries progressed and the Gospel became ever darker by the precepts of men, there were many individuals who began to see <u>a pattern</u>. Namely, what they saw in the Scriptures was <u>not</u> what they saw being practiced. Many desired the previous order of things and set out as best they could to <u>reform</u> the Church of Jesus Christ. The following consists of a few reformers and some of their more famous quotes
