What are they?

The Epitome of Faith and Doctrine

In 1842, Joseph Smith, Jr. wrote a letter to "Long" John Wentworth, editor of the *Chicago Democrat*, which consisted of thirteen fundamental doctrines of the Restoration entitled, "An Epitome of Faith and Doctrine." The letter was published in the Times and Seasons Vol. III, page 710.

This presentation includes additional principles of the Restoration and of the doctrine of Jesus Christ, as included by George Medford.

We believe in God the Eternal Father, and in his Son Jesus Christ, and in the Holy Ghost.

We believe that men will be punished for their own sins, and not for Adam's transgressions.

We believe that through atonement of Christ all mankind may be saved by obedience to the laws and ordinances of the gospel.

We believe that these ordinances are, first, faith in the Lord Jesus Christ; second, repentance; third, baptism by immersion for the remission of sins; fourth, laying on of hands for the gift of the Holy Ghost.

We believe that a man must be called of God by "prophecy, and by laying on of hands" by those who are in authority to preach the gospel and administer the ordinances thereof.

We believe in the same organization that existed in the primitive church; viz., apostles, prophets, pastors, teachers, evangelists, etc.

We believe in the gift of tongues, prophecy, revelation, visions, healing, interpretation of tongues, etc.


We believe the Bible to be the word of God as far as it is translated correctly; we also believe the Book of Mormon to be the word of God.

We believe all that God has revealed, all that he does now reveal, and we believe that he will yet reveal many great and important things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

We believe in the literal gathering of Israel and in the restoration of the Ten Tribes, that Zion will be built upon this continent, that Christ will reign personally upon the earth, and that the earth will be renewed and receive its paradisaic glory.

We claim privilege of worshipping Almighty God according to the dictates of our consciences, and allow all men the same privilege, let them worship how, where, or what they may.

We believe in being honest, true, chaste, benevolent, virtuous, and in doing good to all men; indeed we may say that we follow the admonition of Paul, "we believe all things, we hope all things," we have endured many things, and hope to be able to endure all things. If there is anything virtuous, lovely, or of good report or praiseworthy, we seek after these things.

29:4 And she [Israel] shall be brought down, and shall speak out of the ground and her speech shall be low out of the dust; and her voice shall be as of one that hath a familiar spirit out of the ground, and her speech shall whisper out of the dust. 29:11 And it shall come to pass, that the Lord God shall bring forth unto you the words of a book; and they shall be the words of them which have slumbered. 29:12 And behold, the book shall be sealed; and in the book shall be a revelation from God, from the beginning of the world to the ending thereof. 29:28 But behold, saith the Lord of hosts, I will show unto the children of men, that it is not yet a very little while, and Lebanon shall be turned into a fruitful field; and the fruitful field shall be esteemed as a forest. 29:29 And in that day shall the deaf hear the words of the book, and the eyes of the blind shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness. History explains that Lebanon remained a desert for centuries until the former and latter rains returned early in the nineteenth century. The people there developed a way to irrigate the land, which caused it to become a fruitful land once again. The following is an excerpt from an article published in the *National Tribune* in 1889, Mr. F. G. Carpenter said:

At the present the Jews are coming here by the hundreds...a half century ago [1839] there were only 32 Jewish families in all Jerusalem, and the number in Palestine was only 3,000. Now [1889] there are nearly 50,000 in the Holy Land.



In 1830, there were very few Jews in Palestine, and the country itself was desolate. However, by 1889, there were 50,000 Jews, and another 61,541 returned in 1935. The restoration of the Jews involved more than just people, but it involved the land as well.

An old encyclopedia gives us the situation in Palestine in spoiler's Bana Encyclopedia, Article on Palestine.

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Interestingly, the Book of Mormon was published in 1830 and at that time Palestine was still an unproductive wilderness. However, something in the land began to change shortly thereafter. Please read the following from a book published in 1935, Mr. George T. B. Davis stated:

The change that has taken place in Palestine...is almost unbelievable, and well night beggars description. Swamp lands have been reclaimed, and have given place to waving fields of grain. Sandy wastes have been turned into beautiful orange groves. Desert places have been turned into a veritable garden of Eden. Indeed it is quite probable that such a sudden change from a waste wilderness to a land blossoming as the rose has never before been witnessed in the history of the world.

- \$Stick of Judah = The Bible
- \$Stick of Joseph = The Book of Mormon

Most scholars agree that the stick of Judah is the bible but are reluctant to say what the stick of Joseph is. Some religions claim that the stick of Joseph is the Book of Mormon, that it was written by the descendants of Joseph of the old testament. Writers in the Book of Mormon even state that they are descendants of Joseph.



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11:186 For, said he [Alma], I have repented of my sins, and have been redeemed of the Lord; behold, I am born of the Spirit. 11:187 And the Lord said unto me, Marvel not that all mankind, yea, men, and women, all nations, kindreds, tongues and people, must be born again; 11:188 Yea, born of God, changed from their carnal and fallen state, to a state of righteousness, being redeemed of God, becoming his sons and daughters; and thus they become new creatures; and unless they do this, they can in no wise inherit the kingdom of God. [Mosiah 11:186-188]

3:44 And John went down into the water and baptized him. 3:45 And Jesus when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water; and John saw, and lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and **lighting upon** Jesus. 3:46 And lo, he heard a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear ye him. [Matthew 3:44-46]

2:1 The words of Christ, which he spake unto his disciples, the twelve whom he had chosen, as he laid his hands upon them. 2:2 And he called them by name, saying, Ye shall call on the Father in my name, in mighty prayer; and after ye have done this, ye shall have power that on him whom ye shall lay your hands, ye shall give the Holy Ghost; and in my name shall ye give it, for thus do mine apostles. [Moroni 2:1-2]

8:14 Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John; 8:15 Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost. 8:16 (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them; only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) 8:17 Then laid they their hands on them and they received the Holy Ghost. [Acts 8:14-17]


Laying on of Hands: Blessing of the Children



Laying on of Hands: Ordination

DC 17:12a Every elder, priest, teacher, or deacon, is to be ordained according to the gifts and callings of God unto him; 17:12b and he is to be ordained by the power of the Holy Ghost which is in the one who ordains him.



- 3:19 Wherefore then, the law was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made in the law given to Moses, who was **ordained by the hand of angels** to be a mediator of this first covenant, (the law.) [Galatians 3:49]

6:3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business...and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas...6:6 Whom they set before the apostles; and when they had prayed, they laid their hands on them. 6:7 And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith. 3:1 The manner which the disciples, who were called the elders of the church, ordained priests and teachers. 3:2 After they had prayed unto the Father in the name of Christ, they laid their hands upon them, and said, In the name of Jesus Christ I ordain you to be a priest; (or if he be a teacher;) I ordain you to be a teacher, to preach repentance and remission of sins through Jesus Christ, by the endurance of faith on his name to the end. Amen. 3:3 And after this manner did they ordain priests and teachers, according to the gifts and callings of God unto men; and they ordained them by the power of the Holy Ghost, which was in them. 
Laying on of Hands: Healing

Luke 4:40 Now, when the sun was setting, all they who had any sick, with divers diseases, brought them unto him, and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.

5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, **anointing him with oil** in the name of the Lord; **5:15** And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, **they shall be forgiven him**. [James 5:14-15]

9:17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and **putting his hands on him** said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. **9:18** And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales; and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized. [Acts 9:17-18]

42:12c And whosoever among you are sick, and have not faith to be healed, **but believe**, shall be nourished with all tenderness with herbs and mild food, and that not by the hand of an enemy. **42:12d** And the elders of the church, two or more, shall be called and shall pray for, and **lay their hands upon them** in my name; and if they die, they shall die unto me, and if they live, they shall live unto me. [DC 42:12c-d]



Resurrection from the Dead

John 6:40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up in the resurrection of the just at the last day.

26:22 Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come; 26:23 That Christ should suffer, and that he should be <u>the first</u> that should **rise from the dead**, and should show light unto the people, and to the Gentiles [Acts 26:23]

8:34 Yea, even so he shall be led, crucified and slain, the flesh becoming subject even unto death, the will of the Son being swallowed up in the will of the Father; 8:35 And thus God breaketh the bands of death; having gained the victory over death; giving the Son power to make intercession for the children of men...8:52 Yea, even the Lord, who has redeemed his people; yea, him who has granted salvation unto his people: 8:53 For were it not for the redemption which he hath made for his people, which was prepared from the foundation of the world; I say unto you, were it not for this, all mankind must have perished. 8:54 But behold, the bands of death shall be broken, and the Son reigneth, and hath power over the dead; therefore, he bringeth to pass the resurrection of the dead. [Mosiah 8:34-35; 52-54]

8:9 But ye are not after the flesh, but after the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. 8:10 And if Christ be in you, though the body shall die because of sin, yet the Spirit is life, because of righteousness. 8:11 And if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead, dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. 8:12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, unto sin, ye shall die; but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall *live* unto Christ. Hebrews 9:27 And as it
is appointed unto men
once to die, but after this
judgment;

7:31 For the day soon cometh, that men shall come before me to judgment, to be judged according to their works. [Matthew 7:31]

14:10 But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at naught thy brother? for we shall <u>all</u> stand before the judgment seat of Christ. 14:11 For I live, saith the Lord, as it is written. And every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall swear to God. 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. [Romans 14:10-12]

5:10 For we must <u>all</u> appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that everyone may **receive a reward** of the deeds done in the body; things according to what he hath done, whether good or bad [2 Corinthians 5:10]

DC 42:9b every man shall be made accountable unto me a steward over his own property, or that which he has received by consecration, inasmuch as is sufficient for himself and family.‡

1:27 And I, God, said unto mine Only Begotten, which was with me from the beginning, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness; and it was so. 1:28 And I, God, said, Let them have dominion over the fishes of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth...4:1 And it came to pass, that after I, the Lord God, had driven them out, that Adam began to till the earth, and to have dominion over all the beasts of the field, and to eat his bread by the sweat of his brow, as I, the Lord had commanded him, and Eve also, his wife, did labor with him. [Genesis 1:27-28 and Genesis 4:1]

59:4b verily I say, that inasmuch as ye do this the fullness of the earth is yours: the beasts of the fields, and the fowls of the air, and that which climbeth upon the trees, and walketh upon the earth; 59:4c yea, and the herb, and the good things which come of the earth, whether for food or for raiment, or for houses or for barns, or for orchards, or for gardens, or for vineyards; 59:4d yea, all things which come of the earth, in the season thereof, are made for the benefit and the use of man, both to please the eye, and to gladden the heart; yea, for food and for raiment, for taste and for smell, to strengthen the body, and to enliven the soul. 59:5a And it pleaseth God that he hath given all these things unto man; for unto this end were they made, to be used with judgment, not to excess, neither by extortion: 59:5b and in nothing doth man offend God, or against none is his wrath kindled, save those who confess not his hand in all things, and obey not his commandments. 102:2b but, behold, they have not learned to be obedient to the things which I require at their hands, but are full of all manner of evil, and do not impart of their substance, as becometh Saints, to the poor and afflicted among them, and are not united according to the union required by the law of the celestial kingdom [D&C 102:2b]

38:9c And again I say unto you, I give unto you a commandment, that every man, both elder, priest, teacher, and also member, go to with his might, with the labor of his hands, to prepare and accomplish the things which I have commanded. [DC 38:9c]

What do we believe?

*11. We believe in the spiritual gifts such as wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues and interpretation of tongues, preaching, teaching; in angels; in ministering spirits, given to man by God according to his faith

1 Corinthians 12:3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed; and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

12:5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. 12:6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 12:10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues; 12:11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. [1 Corinthians 12:4-11]

46:5a And again, verily I say unto you, I would that ye should always remember, and always retain in your minds what those gifts are, that are given unto the church, for all have not every gift given unto them; 46:5b for there are many gifts, and to every man is given a gift by the Spirit of God: 46:5c to some it is given one, and to some is given another, that all may be profited thereby; 46:5d to some it is given by the Holy Ghost to know that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and that he was crucified for the sins of the world; 46:5e to others it is given to believe on their words, that they also might have eternal life, if they continue faithful.

What do we believe?

12. We believe in an authoritative Priesthood and that no man can take upon himself this office, but is called by God. A man is ordained by the power of the Holy Ghost through the laying on of hands by those who have authority.

Hebrews 5:4 And no man taketh this honor unto himself, but he that is called of God; as was Aaron. 5:5 So also Christ glorified not himself to be made a high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou are my Son, today have I begotten thee.

15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit; and that your fruit should remain; that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you. [John 15:16]

6:67 And it came to pass, when the Lord had spoken with Adam our father, that Adam cried unto the Lord, and he was caught away by the Spirit of the Lord, and was carried down into the water, and was laid under the water, and was brought forth out of the water; and thus he was baptized. 6:68 And the Spirit of God descended upon him, and thus he was born of the Spirit, and became quickened in the inner man. 6:69 And he heard a voice out of heaven, saying, Thou art baptized with fire and with the Holy Ghost; this is the record of the Father and the Son, from henceforth and forever; 6:70 And thou art after the order of him who was without beginning of days or end of years, from all eternity to all eternity. 



[Isaiah 4:1-5 and Isaiah 60:18-21]

20:1 And I saw an angel come down out of heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled; and after that he must be loosed a little season. 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them; and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshiped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands: and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 20:6 Blessed and holy are they who have part in the first resurrection; on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. [Revelation 20:1-6]

45:10b And at that day when I shall come in my glory, shall the parable be fulfilled which I spake concerning the ten virgins; for they that are wise and have received the truth, and have taken the Holy Spirit for their guide, and have not been deceived, verily I say unto you, 45:10c They shall not be hewn down and cast into the fire, but shall abide the day, and the earth shall be given unto them for an inheritance; 45:10d and they shall multiply and wax strong, and their children shall grow up without sin unto salvation, for the Lord shall be in their midst, and his glory shall be upon them, and he will be their King and their lawgiver.

45:12a Wherefore, I the Lord have said, Gather ye out from the eastern lands, assemble ye yourselves together ye elders of my church; 45:12b go ye forth unto the western countries, call upon the inhabitants to repent, and inasmuch as they do repent, build up churches unto me; 45:12c and with one heart and with one mind, gather up your riches that ye may purchase an inheritance which shall hereafter be appointed unto you, and it shall be called the New Jerusalem, a land of peace, a city of refuge, a place of safety for the saints of the most high God; 45:12d and the glory of the Lord shall be there, and the terror of the Lord also shall be there, insomuch that the wicked will not come unto it; and it shall be called Zion.

45:13a And it shall come to pass, among the wicked, that every man that will not take his sword against his neighbor, must needs flee unto Zion for safety. 45:13b And there shall be gathered unto it out of every nation under heaven; and it shall be the only people that shall not be at war one with another. 45:13c And it shall be said among the wicked, Let us not go up to battle against Zion, for the inhabitants of Zion are terrible, wherefore we can not stand. 45:14 And it shall come to pass that the righteous shall be gathered out from among all nations, and shall come to Zion singing, with songs of everlasting joy. [DC 45:10b-10d, 12-14]

*16. We believe that the highest calling from our Creator is to love God with all our heart, might, mind, and strength and to love our neighbor as ourself

Moroni 10:15 Wherefore, there must be faith; and if there must be faith, there must also be hope; and if there must be hope, there must also be charity; and except ye have charity, ye can in no wise be saved in the kingdom of God

22:35 Master, which is the great commandment in the law? 22:36 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 22:37 This is the first and great commandment. 22:38 And the second is like unto it; Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. 22:39 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. [Matthew 22:35-39]

7:40 And in the garden of Eden gave I unto man his agency; and unto thy brethren have I said, <u>and also</u> gave commandment, that they should love one another; and that they should choose me their Father. [Genesis 7:40]

13:8 Therefore owe no man anything, but to love one another; for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. 13:9 For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. 13:10 Love worketh no ill to his neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law. [Romans 13:8-10]

6:32 And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise. **6:33** For if ye love them only who love you, what reward have you? **For sinners also do even the same**. [Luke 6:32-33]

4:7 Beloved, let us love one another; for love is of God; and everyone that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. 4:8 He that loveth not, knoweth not God; for God is love. 4:9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. 4:10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his son to be the propitiation for our sins. 4:11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another. 4:12 No man hath seen God at any time, except them who believe. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 4:17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as he is, so are we in this world. 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear; because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us. 4:20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar; for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? 4:21 And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also. [1 John 4:7-21]

7:50 And if a man be meek and lowly in heart, and confesses by the power of the Holy Ghost, that Jesus is the Christ, he must needs have charity; for if he have not charity, he is nothing; wherefore he must needs have charity. 7:51 And charity suffereth long, and is kind, and envieth not, and is not puffed up, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil, and rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth, beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things; wherefore, my beloved brethren, if ye have not charity, ye are nothing, for charity never faileth.

7:52 Wherefore, cleave unto charity, which is the greatest of all, for all things must fail; but charity is the pure love of Christ, and it endureth for ever; and whoso is found possessed of it at the last day, it shall be well with them. 7:53 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, pray unto the Father with all the energy of heart, that ye may be filled with this love which he hath bestowed upon all who are true followers of his Son Jesus Christ, that ye may become the sons of God, that when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is, that we may have this hope, that we may be purified even as he is pure.
