




God said, "Let <u>us</u> make man in <u>our</u> image, after our likeness." [Genesis 1:26]. Who was God referring too when He said "us" and "our?" The Apostle John testified that the Word, who is Jesus Christ, was with God in the beginning, and was the Lamb who was "slain from the foundation of the world." [Revelation 13:8].

1:1 In the <u>beginning</u> was the <u>Word</u>, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God... 1:14 And the <u>Word was made flesh</u>, and dwelt among us [John 1:1-2, 14]

The following Scriptures testify that Christ was not merely a Jew of the first century, but that He existed before the creation as the Master prayed in the seventeenth chapter of John. "And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee <u>before</u> the world was." [John 17:5].

1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature: 1:16 For by him were *all things created*, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible...*all things* were created *by him*, and for him: 1:17 And he is *before* all things, and *by him* all things consist. [Colossians 1:14-17]



1:1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds... 1:10 And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands. [Hebrews 1:1-2, 10]
